Thanks to a client of ours, Lucie, who works for Blue Cross as a nurse in charge of repatriating Blue Cross Members in needs of urgent medical care. I must admit I was unaware of such services and this is why I would like to thank Lucie and share with you some of the references she kindly submitted to us.

The Canadian government has put together a booklet '*Well on your way*' for Canadians living or travelling abroad. It includes essential information on understanding travel health risks; taking preventive measures before, during and after your travel; coping with a health emergency abroad; and accessing consular services in a health emergency. 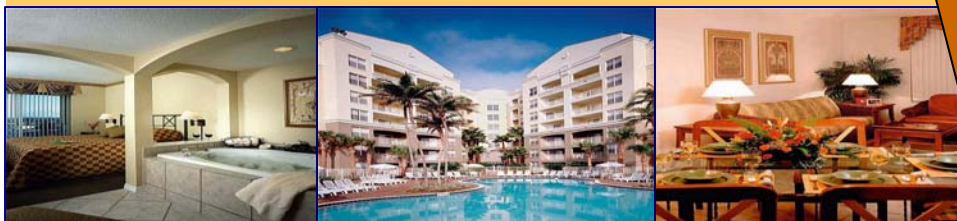
Something else you should know is that your Provincial Health Plan does not always cover all medical expenses while out of the country or even out of the province, for that matter. And, if it does, it pays only up to the concurrent provincial established rates for any particular medical care. What that means is that you could well be taking high financial risks should anything happen to you or your family while abroad.
